

Establishing PMO at AstraZeneca

When AstraZeneca partnered with Oxford to develop a COVID-19 vaccine, it faced immense pressure. A PMO was launched in just a week to manage contracts, streamline processes, and mitigate risk - leading to the successful delivery of 1B+ doses across 170 countries by July 2021.



Digital Transformation of ILDC Bank

ILDC Bank transformed from a traditional setup to a fully digital ecosystem, redefining customer experience for modern India. The case captures the strategy, execution, and innovation behind building a scalable, tech-driven retail banking model in a rapidly evolving digital landscape.



Township Project Construction by SLA Group

Learners manage the end-to-end construction of a 10-story residential complex using the Waterfall model. They define scope, plan costs, address risks, and apply EVM to monitor progress. The project ends with a handover, stakeholder review, and lessons learned.



Smartphone Development

IL Technologies' launching a new smartphone using a Hybrid Project Management approach. Hardware follows a Predictive model with fixed specs and timelines, while software runs on Agile with sprints, stand-ups, and user feedback. Integration checkpoints align both streams. The project wraps up with system testing, launch, and a post-launch review, emphasizing stakeholder communication, risk planning, and change management.



Toyota Kirloskar's Lean Implementation in Manufacturing

Learners apply Lean Six Sigma to real-world process optimisation at Toyota Kirloskar. They identify inefficiencies, analyse root causes, and implement sustainable improvements - enhancing productivity, reducing waste, and embedding a culture of continuous operational excellence.




